**Writing Practice gives you the tools to be able to "jump off" with your
writing at any time, to write fast for 10 minutes or 20 or 30 about any
story you wish to share. Writing Practice is a nonjudgmental form of
writing. Mostly what we are trying to do is just get the stories down onto
paper. Then we can edit and critique them later to put into a letter, a
family memoir journal, photo journal or some other document. Writing
Practice gives you a formula to be able to write without worrying about
whether is is "good" or "right" but rather to record in your own
handwriting, the stories the way you remember them.**
